Patron Behavior Policy – The director presented an updated Patron Behavior Policy. Policy updates address recent issues with panhandling, inappropriate touching, clothing, cell phone pictures and video taping, interference with staff, and unattended minors. Emily made a motion to accept the policy and Kim seconded the motion with the change to the unattended minors section to read, "The library staff takes no responsibility for any minor still present at the building at closing but does retain the right to contact police if they feel it is necessary."

Quotes for drainage work – The director presented two estimates for the proposed drainage work.

Chuck Breeding - \$1.500

Novak Excavating – verbal quote, estimate in writing was not submitted as requested

After discussion, Cathy made a motion to accept the quote from Chuck Breeding. Gene seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

In addition to the drainage work, the director suggested reworking the landscaping in front of the library. Tracy described unwanted patron activity on the front porch area and suggested the removal of the overgrown plants and bushes would help deter the activity.
