

## **Parking and Towing Policy**

The Crawford County Public Library lot is intended for the benefit of Library patrons, staff, volunteers and contractors while utilizing library services or performing work. Use of the library parking lot areas must conform to applicable local, state and federal laws and regulations as well as CCPL's Patron Behavior Policy. Overnight and long-term parking are prohibited uses of the parking lot.

Unauthorized use of the Library's parking lot may result in the offending vehicle being towed away at the owner's expense. Requests for use of library parking areas or grounds for purposes unrelated to Library services will be considered by the Library Director on a case-by-case basis. Library activities and services take precedence over any other use.

Library patrons are not authorized to park in front of the Library's main entry way and will be asked to move their vehicle to a designated parking slot. Refusal to move the vehicle will result in towing at the owners expense.

The Crawford County Public Library assumes no responsibility for vehicles, bicycles, motorcycles, or scooters and their contents while parked on the Library's parking lot. In the event of theft or accident, patrons will be encouraged to file a police report.
